NOTES: About 10 minutes before the start of the net, announce the net will be starting. Early contact will allow you to check your radio, the repeater, and allow time to monitor for any emergency or priority traffic. If priority traffic exists, you can either move the net to the backup repeater or cancel it. Following the net, it is advisable to remain on frequency for a period of time to monitor for late traffic and questions. Please do not "quick-key" the repeater or it will timeout.
